
Using spell check

Any form that uses the "Word" control has built in spell check capabilities. Spell check is done "on demand" and by default the language used is English (US).

The sample below is showing the Quote Document / Text element module, but the "Word" control can also be found in various other modules in the Quotation Tool.

To spell check your text, click on the **Review** button in the toolbar.



Then click on the **Spelling** button.

If the spell checker finds any oddities, a dialog (shown above) will be presented and you can take action if needed.
